CEDELEQ V is an event organized by McGill University, the Education Office of the Embassy of Spain in Ottawa, the Centre for Spanish Resources, the University of Montreal, UQÀM and APEQ (Association of Spanish Teachers of Quebec), whose main objective is to create a forum for professors, instructors, and researchers to discuss recent contributions in the field of ELE teaching and learning, as well as its impact in the ELE class.



The Organizing Committee of the *V Coloquio sobre la Enseñanza del Español, Lengua Extranjera, en Quebec* (CEDELEQ V) is pleased to invite professors and researchers to submit a proposal to the fifth edition of the convention, which will take place from Thursday, May 7<sup>th</sup> to Saturday, May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2015 at McGill University.

## Invitation to participate

Modalities of participation:

- Papers: 30 minutes (25 minutes + 5 minutes for questions)
- Workshops: 1 hour (45 minutes + 15 minutes for discussion and questions)
- Poster presentations (45'5x46): These sessions will take place on Friday, May 8th.

Proposals should discuss one of the following topics:

- 1) Grammars and methods for ELE teaching and learning
- 2) New technologies in ELE
- 3) Didactic materials for the ELE class
- 4) Language and culture in the ELE class
- 5) Dialectic norms and variables in the ELE class
- 6) Educational and formative frameworks for teachers

The proposal for participation should include the following information:

- The title of the presentation
- Name and affiliation of the author(s)
- Modality: paper, workshop, or poster talk
- Topic of the presentation 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 6
- Postal address
- Telephone number
- E-mail address
- Summary in Spanish (350 words), which should include the objectives and development of the proposal.
- Equipment needed for the presentation: projector, computer, and Internet connection.

Although Spanish is the official language of the CEDELEQ, presentations in French and English are also welcome.

Proposals must be sent as attached documents to the Organizing Committee before the 3<sup>rd</sup> of November 2014 to [cedeleg5@gmail.com](mailto:cedeleg5@gmail.com).

Notifications regarding approval or refusal of proposals will be sent by e-mail on Monday, January 19<sup>th</sup>, 2015.

Under particular circumstances, the Organizing Committee will consider the possibility of allowing a speaker to participate in the convention via videoconference.

Observing previous CEDELEQ convention practices, a selection of papers and workshops presented at the convention will be published in the CEDELEQ V Proceedings.
